Course description:

This course focuses on the health care needs of adult and elderly clients suffering from common acute and chronic disorders. Building on the foundations of previous nursing courses and the nursing process, Associate Degree Nursing student will examine the impacts of altered health states and plan nursing care for clients and their families. Topics include the nursing care of clients who are experiencing selected basic health alterations related to the body systems.
